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the APR is based on the Prime Rate (Index) plus a margin of Prime Plus 5.74% to 11.00% (currently 9.99% - 15.25%). Your APR will be calculated by adding a margin from above to the Prime Rate as correctly published in the Wall Street Journal as of the 15th day of the month immediately preceding the billing cycle. The Credit Union may adjust the rate once each month effective the first day of the billing cycle. APR changes will reflect on the following month's statement. The APR will never be greater than 18.00%. Any increase in the annual percentage rate will take the form of additional payments shown as Total Minimum Payments on the statement. If the Index is no longer available, the Credit Union will choose a new index which is based upon comparable information. Offer subject to change at any time without notice. **After 12 months, the normal Balance Transfer Fee will apply to

On Sunday, December 10, 2017, Centra employees found evidence of ATM skimmers on three Centra ATM locations and one ATM skimmer device was recovered. The impacted locations are 2125 Veterans Parkway in Jeffersonville, 3010 State Street in Columbus and 651 Hamburg Way in Sellersburg. All three ATMs have been secured and are safe to use. For your protection, we closed the debit cards of Members who had recently used these ATMs. If your Centra Debit Card has been closed, please visit your nearest Centra Location to receive a new card instantly.
